OLD BUSINESS

General Update on Cemetery Business

SKS Engineers is preparing a plan for the upcoming road improvement project. There are five areas that should receive immediate attention.

Temporary summer employees have been hired. The cemetery is fully staffed (3 full-time employees and 3 summer/temporary employees).

Classy Grasses removed scrub brush and weeds from the east side hill and sprayed the area with hydro seeding. Due to a lack of rain, a 500-gallon water tank and pump have been rented, at a cost of \$200/day, from Sun Belt for watering.

During the week of May 19, Greenwood Cemetery suffered a significant amount of storm damage. Several trees and headstones were damaged. Headstone repairs are not the responsibility of the Township. Additional damage occurred to one of the sheds and concrete. Bids have been submitted, and repairs are expected to be completed before winter.

On Memorial Day, the cemetery board welcomed cemetery visitors with carnations.

NEW BUSINESS

A 2015 Dodge Ram 4x4 was purchased to replace the old flatbed truck that is no longer operational.
